North Peel offers a unique selection of applied, locally developed, workplace, college and open courses. Upon graduation, North Peel students receive an Ontario Secondary School Diploma or Certificate, as well as a distinctive graduation portfolio, which lists specific skills the student has mastered, and a work performance record. The graduation portfolio tells employers what they want to know, giving North Peel graduates an edge when looking for employment.
