More about Peel Alternative School:

Peel Alternative School offers an alternative program for Peel students in Grades 7 to 12 whose needs are better addressed in a small education centre or through online learning.

The secondary programs include:

- ❖ Intermediate Alternative Program – for Grade 9 and 10 students under 16
- ❖ Foundations – for Grade 9 and 10 students over 16
- ❖ Senior – for Grade 11 and 12 students over 16
- ❖ TELL – for Grade 10-12 students over 16
- ❖ PAS Online – online courses for senior students over 16
- ❖ TEAM – for teen mothers

Students in the Intermediate Alternative Program must attend school every day. Students in the Foundations, Senior and TELL programs must attend school two hours/week per course.

Alternative Program students have learning needs which are not met in a regular secondary school. Courses offered vary based upon enrolment, student interest and facilities.

The goal for most students enrolled in Alternative Programs is reintegration within a regular secondary school. Referral to the Peel Alternative School is done through a student's home school.
